Abtract

The purposes of this research were 1) to study the Wildlife Sanctuary's administrative process about planning, organizing, commanding, coordinating and controlling; 2) to study the Wildlife Sanctuary's management effectiveness about Wildlife Management, forest management and participation in wildlife management; 3) to compare the Wildlife Sanctuary's management achievement according to the level of administrative process; 4) to study problems and suggestions in wildlife management.

The sample group consisted of 290 subjects. These comprising officer rangers and employees of the Wildlife Sanctuary drivers, forest officers, personal and members of sub-district administration organization in the area which the Wildlife Sanctuary covered. Questionnaires created by the researcher were used as a tool for data collection. The SPSS for WINDOWS was used in data analysis to determine the percentage, mean, standard deviation, One-way analysis and Analysis of Variance.

The findings

The results indicated that the overall management process of the Wildlife Sanctuary in the Northeast of Thailand was good; that of planning was good; that of organizing was good; that of commanding was good; that of coordinating was good; and that of controlling was good.

The management achievement of the Wildlife Sanctuary in the Northeast of Thailand was good; wildlife management achievement was good; forest management achievement was good; and management participation achievement was fair.

The management achievement of the Wildlife Sanctuary in the Northeast of Thailand classified according to the different level of administrative process revealed that this achievement had a 0.05 level of significant difference in that a high level of administrative process achievement rendered the Wildlife Sanctuary management achievement higher than medium and low levels; similarly, a medium level of administrative process achievement rendered the Wildlife Sanctuary management achievement higher than low level.
